## What We Do

- 1 We conduct needs assessments in rural communities to identify specific areas where appropriate technology can improve quality of life, such as water and sanitation, agriculture, and energy access.
- 2 Develop appropriate technologies that address the needs of rural communities in Papua New Guinea and other developing countries.
- 3 Disseminate knowledge and information on appropriate technology to local communities, organisations and governments to enhance their capacity to adopt and use these technologies.
